

Consultation on increasing published admission numbers (PAN) at Hartlebury C of E Primary School

Hartlebury C of E Primary School is situated in an area of population growth and physical expansion is needed to help the Local Authority to meet its duty to supply sufficient school places from 2019-20, catering for the increased number of students coming through the primary school system in the years ahead.

An increase in published admission numbers (PAN) of 5 from 25 to 30 in each year group is planned from 2019-20 which will start with Reception before increasing incrementally each year until 2026-27. There will be no change to the Admissions arrangements.

We appreciate that an increase in size, however small, may be seen as having an impact on other local schools although the change is aligned with local pupil place plans as outlined by the Local Authority and all required funding is in place with appropriate planning permissions and consents to support the proposals to fund a new classroom. There is no thought that this number will be increased again in the future.

We are keen to ensure that views of all parties affected are sought and considered. Interested parties are encouraged to comment on the proposals which we hope will be received favourably, particularly in view of the planned demand for places in the future.
